Erasmus Policy Statement

The main objective of our institution's international strategy is to focus on logistics in its broadest sense. In the period 2014-2020 we intend to continue the successful cooperation in the field of logistics.

We choose our partners from institutions dealing with the above mentioned field, i.e. logistics. One way to find new partners is through workshops and conferences. There we find opportunities to share knowledge and to start further cooperation.

College of Logistics annually participates in activities such as international conference SpeedChain. There is a special section enabling meeting of various universities and universities of applied sciences teaching logistics. Another option is to be a member of a group, for example in the field of logistics- EFLE- European Forum of Logistics Education. College of Logistics focuses on all the European countries. The most important objective of our mobility activities is a successful cooperation which includes students and staff exchanges, the exchange of experience and sustainable development in logistics education in first and second cycle of education. College of Logistics has been invited to participate in Joint degrees project as a partner.

College of Logistics has participated in international projects in the field of logistics, tourism, and logistics of services since 2007. College of Logistics was a partner of subproject under the INTERREG III programme. College of Logistics has published the materials in English – Czech – Polish language. College of Logistics' priorities are to send staff members to find new partners for further cooperation in projects. College of Logistics has been quite successful in this area. For example the last successful project dealt with the international cooperation on the diploma thesis between two participating partners, Polish and Czech. The project started after the teaching mobility of one of our staff members, who had negotiated the goals and aims of the project during his mobility. The students worked on similar topics of their thesis under the specialist supervision at the same time. The aim of the project was to focus on the same point from the different views, to start cooperation between students and to publish their results in bilingual versions.
